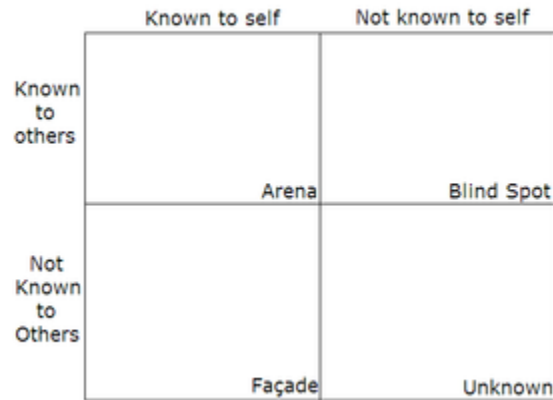




### Johari Window

#### The Johari Window Reflection:

Reflect on the different aspects of your identity and what is seen and shared through different window panes.

Open pane: What is known to self and others (examples: hair color, physical appearance):

Hidden pane: What is open to self but hidden from others (examples: information you may want to keep private such as dreams or ambitions):

Blind pane: What is blind to self but seen by others (examples: you may think you are a poor leader but others think you show strong leadership skills):

Unknown pane: What is unknown to self and others (examples: hidden talents you have not explored or uncovered):

Consider what aspects of their identity your students and families bring and what different panes they may represent:
